## Description

The shallow oval bowl, which tapers toward each end, opens into a small handle on each. Two small rectangles are inlaid on each of the handles as mother-of-pearl inlays. A hole has been drilled in the bottom to attach a plant fiber cord for suspension. The bowl received a coat of brown paint.
