## Description

The shallow oval bowl carved from wood tapers to the sides, where it opens into two small handles. Two small rectangular mother-of-pearl inlays are placed on each of the handles. The shell was given a coat of brown paint. A hole is drilled in the center of the bottom towards the rim to attach a plant fiber cord for hanging.
