## Description

Carved from dark wood, this oval bowl tapers towards the sides. On the two sides are carved out two small handles. Two mother-of-pearl inlays of rectangular shape are placed on each of the handles. The bowl is painted with dark color. At the bottom a hole is drilled to attach a coconut fiber cord for hanging.
