Description

Male upright figure, which is rather crudely worked and unsmudged. The legs are very short in relation to the body and elongated head, and the feet are not elaborated. The arms are elongated against the body. The limb with testicles is clearly carved out. The face is determined by a prominent elongated nose. The eye sockets are empty, and the mouth consists of a slit. From the head go elongated ears. On the head there is a metal ring and a short metal chain.
