Description

Male upright wooden figure with straddled legs, using the natural torsion of the yellowish-brown wood, which probably comes from a branch fork. The right leg is led to a lunge to the side, so that the figure stands only on the left leg as a standing leg. The left arm is elongated and placed against the body in such a way that the hand seems to touch the relatively large limb. The head is elongated with pronounced lips and eyebrows. The feet are not fully sculpted. The figure represents a male spirit being.
