Fan made from coconut leaves with ribbing. It ends in a flattened edge with a triangular wave pattern and has a simple and regular design. The upper end of the fan is straight and does not taper. There is a hole pattern on the left and right edges of the fan. The handle is very small and is wrapped with dark and light coconut fibers that create a pattern.
